Dear Friends in Christ,

As Peter concludes his 2nd evangelistic sermon, found in the book of Acts, he boldly and passionately declares the following invitation to his awakened congregation. "Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord." When you consider the content of his immediate audience, the apostle gives quite a fearless and amazing call to conversion. Many in this crowd had vehemently opposed the Lord Jesus Christ; slandered the Lord's holy character; mocked His majestic teachings and ultimately they were guilty of murdering the Son of God! Up to this point, they were completely blinded and ignorant of God's eternal purpose and plan, concerning the person and the work of the Lord Jesus Christ. Peter courageously confronted their spiritual blindness, ignorance and rebellion, by saying, "But you denied the Holy One and the Just, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, and killed the Prince of life, whom God raised from the dead, of which we are witnesses." Yet friends, it was through this vicious act of the crucifixion of Jesus, that God fulfilled HIS GLORIOUS SALVATION PLAN. God used the most wicked crime that was ever committed by man, to bring about the greatest blessing that could ever be known by man! Our Sovereign Lord used all of their foul iniquities, their stiff-necked rebellion and their homicidal retribution, to serve HIS SAVING PURPOSES, in the redemption of sinners! Isn't that absolutely astounding and amazing grace! The Holy Spirit put it this way in Acts 2:23, "Him, (Jesus), being delivered by the determined purpose and fore-knowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death."

However, precious friends, Peter, does not conclude the message by only proclaiming the plan and purpose of God in the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus. He passionately pleads with them to 'repent and be converted', so that their sins may be blotted out. He compassionately tells them that if they will only turn from their sins and believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, they will receive what he calls, "times of refreshing from the presence of the Lord". By using this phrase, Peter is painting a beautiful picture of the glorious blessings of salvation. He is saying, that this salvation is comparable to a man who is confined in an enclosed prison cell, with no windows and no exit. The blazing heat of the sun has been shining upon the roof of this cell, which is without any ventilation. The sun's penetrating rays have produced suffocating and sweltering temperatures, within this cell. The prisoner is at the point of complete asphyxiation from this condition. When suddenly, there is a wind of refreshing air that miraculously sweeps into the room. The prisoner is amazingly revived and restored by that 'life-giving' wind of fresh air. This cooling, regenerating wind has moved in and revitalized his very life! This is the picture Peter uses in attempting to describe the miraculous breath of the Holy Spirit!

On the day of Pentecost, the mighty Wind of the Spirit of God had swept into the lives of the disciples in that upper room; and now, they were filled with the Wind of God, (Holy Spirit), and the Word of God. It was just a few weeks prior, that this same Peter had denied His Lord before the accusation of a servant girl. Yet now, the presence and power of the Spirit of God has filled Peter with holy boldness, a confident compassion, and a steadfast assurance. He is unashamedly preaching the undiluted message of the Person of Jesus; the Work of Jesus; and the Terms of Jesus, to the very people who had brutally murdered the Lord Jesus Christ. Peter is pleading with them, concerning the claims of Christ; and longing that they might come to know these: 'TIMES OF REFRESHING FROM THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD'!

Friends, do you see the lost men and women around you as "never-dying" souls, who are in bondage to the oppressive suffocation of their own desperately wicked hearts?

Do you see them as slaves who are imprisoned, under the tyranny of sin, darkness, and death?

Do you recognized that they are chasing all of the amusements, trinkets and distractions that this world has to offer; attempting to satisfy the longing of their thirsty souls, by things that are empty, futile, and leads to death?

Do you realize that only these 'times of refreshing from the presence of the Lord' can truly fulfill the longings of their soul and deliver them from the suffocation of their sin?

Oh, friends, may we make a new commitment to intercede, asking for the Wind of God to blow on their lives.



I Peter 3:15 - But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to

give a defense to every one who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear

Oh, that all, who have been refreshed, would make a new commitment to "take opportunities and make opportunities" to share the truths concerning the Person of Jesus, the Work of Jesus, and the Terms of Jesus, with those within the realm of our lives. May the mighty Wind of God blow in our souls and through our lives.

We sensed God's power and pleasure upon your ministry to us. Thank you for giving to the Lord!"
