

III. THE NATURE OF THE OBJECT OF THE DISCIPLE'S PURSUIT OF HOLINESS

Sanctification means 'to be set apart for a special purpose'.

It is to be set apart **from** a former use; and to be set apart **unto** a new use.

Romans 6:19 - I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves of uncleanness, and of lawlessness leading to more lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves of righteousness for holiness.

I Thessalonians 4:7 - For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness.

II Timothy 2:20-21 - But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, <u>sanctified</u> and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.




